The Kentucky Preschool Partnership Grant is designed to incentivize cooperative public/private partnerships between public school districts and child care providers to develop full-day, high-quality programs for at-risk children. This grant source would be in force for 2 years.

This partnership will allow Thelma B Johnson, ELC, Kidz World, and Little Stars to begin a partnership for the 2021-22 and 2022-23 school years. The partnership grant will provide 30 students with full-day preschool services four days a week through the hiring of an additional classroom teacher and four Instructional Assistants. 15 students will attend the Monday/Wednesday classes and 15 students will attend the Tuesday/Thursday sessions allowing them four full days of instruction.

This grant would be used during the two years it was in force to pay for the salary of one certified preschool teacher and 4 classified preschool instructional assistants. It would also cover trainings, materials, and mileage to implement the program.
