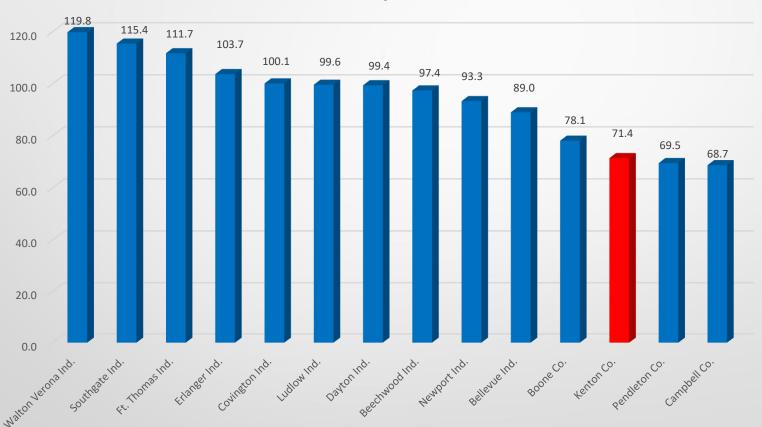
Northern KY School District Tax Rates 2020-21

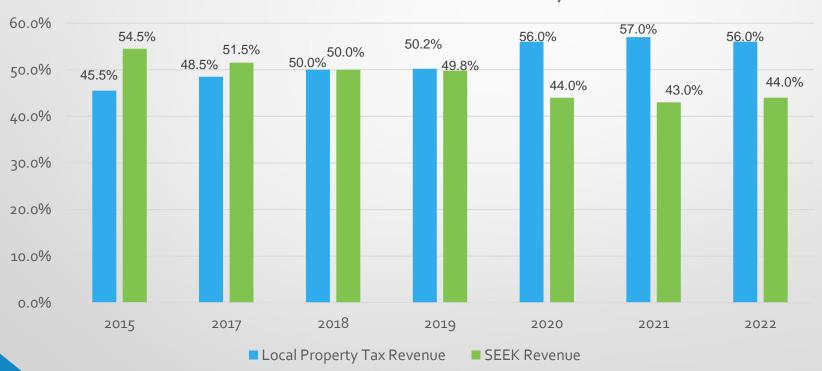

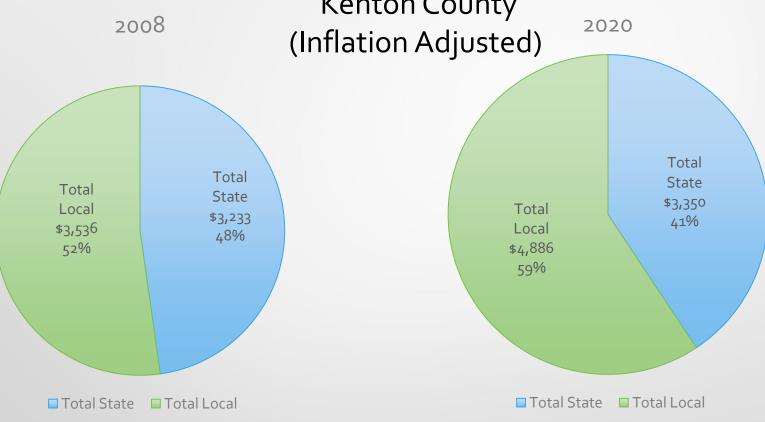

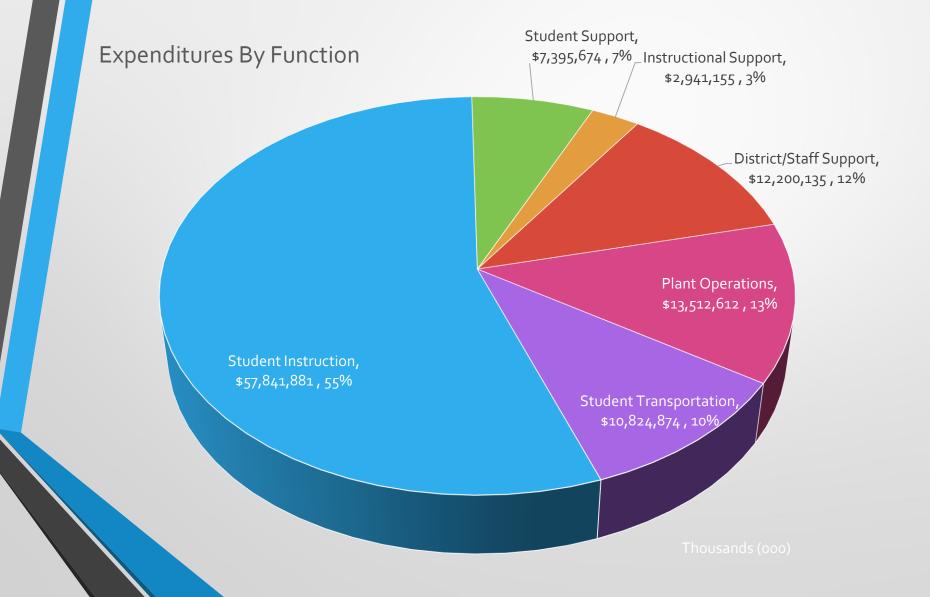
