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

The Rising Sun Conference will be held September 10-11 at the Kentucky FFA Leadership Training Center in Hardinsburg. The conference will begin at 6:00 p.m. on Friday, September 10 and conclude no later than 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 11.

The Rising Sun Conference will be open to up to two officers per chapter. We hope that the regions can continue to coordinate travel for this conference as has been done in the past.

During the conference:

- Chapters and regions will work together to identify the resources and steps needed to meet their goals, including the support needed from the association.
- State officers will present sessions about the state goals, how the chapters are involved in those goals, tips for success, and methods to share those goals with the membership.
- Action plans will be developed for chapters, regions, and the association.

Registration: All attendees (members and advisors) are asked to register online by August 15. (Late registrations will be accepted through August 30

but no shirt will be provided for late registrants.)



