We are pleased to be partnering with your program for a third year of membership in our Network for Alternative Schools (NAS). This year, as a result of travel-restrictions and district modifications related to the CoVid-19 pandemic, we have adapted the NAS design, tailoring specifically to the individual needs and schedule availability of your program. For Bullitt Alternative Center, Kat Crawford, Schlechty Center's Executive Director of Digital Innovation, has designed a series of professional learning experiences and virtual tools built around the following intended results:

- Learn about best practices for engagement in schools that work with at-risk populations.
- Create a framework to support an alternative school as a learning organization.
- Share resources and digital tools to increase engagement and student learning.
- Raise awareness of high-need areas such as designing engaging work, behavior management, intake, transition, designing learning for the transient student, social and emotional learning, trauma-informed care, engaging students with credit recovery, student voice, and technology integration.

As part of your customized package, we will provide access for up to 13 users to our Designing for Engagement in Alternative Schools tools, including all four learning modules. Kat will lead the design and facilitation of five professional development days for your school, focusing on a deep dive into the design of new work, coaching around current challenges, and designing for engagement. Kat will also be available for coaching sessions with teachers and counselors each month.

The four modules of the Designing for Engagement in Alternative Schools will support teachers as they approach learning in a highly transitional environment and design work that students will need to be engaged. The deep dive sessions will focus on taking the content from the modules and applying it to your classrooms. The coaching time will be used to give feedback on the projects and work that teachers are designing. Lastly, we will focus on engagement and discuss ways that all staff can design with engagement in mind.

The total fee for this customized package of professional learning and coaching is **\$20,000 for the 2021–2022 academic year.**

We sincerely hope that your district will continue to partner with the Center through these efforts. Together we know we will see great gains in engagement for academically-challenged students and disengaged youth. If you are ready to commit, simply sign below and return via email.
