Consent Item: Consider/Approve Bates Security Bid for School Access Control Systems.

Applicable Statute or Regulation: KRS 158.162 (3)(d)

Budgetary Impact: Source of funding for project will derive from *School Security Funds* (\$155,232.00), Kentucky Department of Education. The remaining balance will be paid from ESSER funds, General fund, and/or Safe School funds to ensure that Floyd County Schools are in compliance with the “exterior door access control” requirements pursuant to KRS 158.162.

Background and Major Policy Implications: KRS 158.162 (3) requires that “Each local board of education shall require the school council or, if none exists, the principal in each school building to: ... (d) Develop and adhere to practices to control the access to each school building. Practices shall include but not be limited to: 1. Controlling outside access to exterior doors during the school day; ...” Also, KRS 158.162 (7) states that “A district with a school not in compliance with the requirements of subsection (3)(d) of this section by July 1, 2022, shall not be eligible for approval by the Kentucky Department of Education for new building construction or expansion in the 2022-2023 school year and any subsequent year without verification of compliance, except for facility improvements that specifically address the school safety and security requirements of this section, when deemed necessary for the protection of student or staff health and safety, or to comply with other legal requirements or orders.”

Therefore, Floyd County Schools seeks to engage a highly qualified security integrator who is an authorized RBH access control installer and integrator for the expansion of our existing RBH access control system to 9 new locations (James D. Adams Middle; Allen Elementary; Betsy Layne Elementary; Duff-Allen Central Elementary; May Valley Elementary; Prestonsburg Elementary; Renaissance Learning Center/Floyd County School of Innovation; John M. Stumbo Elementary; and South Floyd Elementary) within our school district. Each of the 9 new sites shall have card readers, electronic locks, and status switches. Door status switches shall be installed on all exterior doors. All doors and status switches are to communicate seamlessly with our existing Axiom XA professional edition software/server.


- June 28, 2021

- August 3, 2021
 - Invitations to bid with specifications for Access Control Systems project were sent via email to vendors as follows:



 - One bid for the Access Control Systems project was received, prepared by Bates Security, LLC. The aforementioned Central Office staff members opened the envelope to review and discuss the proposed bid. Total cost for Access Control Systems project: \$299,494.00.

Recommended Action: Accept and approve Bates Security, LLC, dba ABCO Security bid as presented.

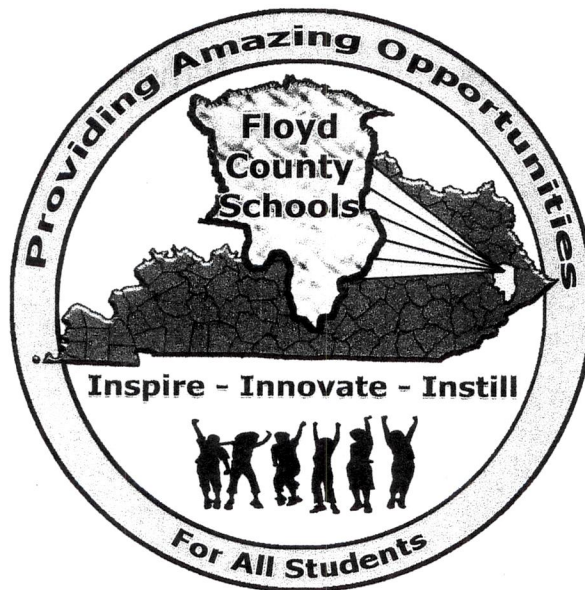

SECTION I

STATEMENT OF WORK

PART 1: GENERAL

- The Floyd County School System seeks to engage a highly qualified security integrator who is an authorized RBH access control inc. installer and integrator; for the expansion of our existing RBH access control system to 9 new locations within our school district. Each of the 9 new sites shall have no less than 4 access control doors complete with card readers, electronic locks, and status switches Door status switches shall be installed on all exterior doors (see maps for exact number of card readers and exterior door switches.) All doors and status switches are to communicate seamlessly with our existing Axiom XA professional edition software/server. (See project description for more technical information.)
- This document describes the system requirements and the parameters of installation and maintenance needed for providing a proposal for this Project. The Owner, Floyd County Schools, shall be referred to as the "FCS" or "Owner" hereinafter.
- All interfaces within the Access Control System shall be based on TCP/IP network protocol connectivity over the corporate intranet/ internet/ LAN/WAN.

Part 2: Project Description

Each of the 9 new sites shall have no less than 4 access control doors complete with card readers, electronic locks, and status switches. In addition, Door status switches shall be installed on all exterior doors.

All doors and status switches are to communicate seamlessly with our existing Axiom XA professional edition software/server. The goal of this expansion project is to have no less than 4 access control doors at each site complete with card readers, electronic locks, and door status switches on all exterior doors at each site. Once completed there should be no less

than 4 access points in which staff shall enter through using their access card or their phone via bluetooth communication. The status of all exterior doors shall be known via the installed status switches. If any exterior door is opened we shall be notified via the Axiom XA software which should be configured to send email notifications that the door has been opened. The warranty license for the axiom XA software shall be extended a further 3 years and should also be included in your bid. See attached maps reader locations are marked with a red X. (some sites have up to 9 readers)

Part 3: Project Requirements

- All wire runs shall utilize existing cable trays and ladder racks. Wire drops shall be run inside walls or with a surface metal conduit if the wall is not hollow or accessible. No wires shall be exposed upon completion of this project.
- All necessary tools, equipment, hardware, software and software user licenses required as described in this document for the complete installation of the Access Control System shall be supplied and installed in this bid.
- Bids should also include Software support and warranty renewal for the Axiom XA software. The software license should be no less than 3 years of warranty and support.
- The status of all exterior doors should be known at each location upon completion of this project.
- There shall be a total of no less than 4 accessible doors utilizing a card and or mobile credential via bluetooth at each site.
- Each control panel should contain a battery for backup purposes in the event of AC power loss. The battery should have enough capacity to power the access points for no less than 24 hours.
- 1000 access cards should be included in your bid. These cards should be printable on both sides.
- Main entrance doors are already equipped with an electronic lock only system that is activated via a button press by the attendant. Upon completion of the project the attendant should still have this capability.

Installer Requirements:

- Installer Must be an authorised RBH installer and integrator.
- In case of system trouble or malfunction, the installer must be able to provide service within a 24 hour time period.
- Quoted hardware must fully integrate with our existing axiomXA server.
- If the specifications listed in this document are not met, the bid may be disqualified.
- 24 hour tech support should be provided in the event an operator of the system needs technical assistance.

Part 4: Technical Requirements**Card readers: (No less than 4 at each site)**

The system shall be provided to control access into designated security controlled doors only by personnel with a valid access card or Identification-PIN and within a valid time schedule. All access cards shall be authenticated against the central and/or local database before granting access. Below are the specifications of the card readers and should meet the following requirements.

Pursuant to KRS 45A.365 and Board Policy 04.32, the Floyd County Board of Education seeks to engage a highly qualified security integrator who is an authorized RBH access control, inc. installer and integrator; for the expansion of our existing RBH access control system to 9 new locations within our school district. We are hereby providing notice that the Board will receive sealed bids for this project.

All envelopes must be clearly marked **SEALED BID- Access Control** on the outside of the envelope. All proposals must be received by the time designated and none will be considered thereafter. The Board of Education cannot assume the responsibility for any delay as a result of failure of the mails to deliver the bids on time. FAXED OR EMAILED BIDS CANNOT BE EXCEPTED. Proposals will be publicly opened and recorded at the time and location stated above.

The contract(s) may be awarded to the lowest and/or best evaluated qualified proposal(s) meeting all specifications and conditions, subject to all other provisions of the items/services request for proposal and be in the best interest of The Board of Education. A one year contract with the option to renew annually for each item/service listed above is scheduled to be awarded at the board meeting to be held at 6:30 PM, August 23, 2021 at the Floyd County Board of Education, 442 KY RT. 550, Eastern, KY 41622.

PROHIBITION AGAINST CONFLICTS OF INTEREST, GRATUITIES AND KICKBACKS

ANY EMPLOYEE OR ANY OFFICIAL OF THE FLOYD COUNTY SCHOOLS, ELECTIVE OR APPOINTIVE, WHO SHALL TAKE, RECEIVE, OR OFFER TO TAKE OR RECEIVE, EITHER DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, AND REBATE, PERCENTAGE OF CONTRACT, MONEY, OR OTHER THINGS OF VALUE, AS AN INDUCEMENT OR INTENDED INDUCEMENT, IN THE PROCUREMENT OF BUSINESS, OR THE GIVING OF BUSINESS, FOR, OR TO, OR FROM, ANY PERSON, PARTNERSHIP, FIRM OR CORPORATION, OFFERING, BIDDING FOR, OR IN OPEN MARKET SEEKING TO MAKE SALES TO THE FLOYD COUNTY SCHOOLS, SHALL BE DEEMED GUILTY OF A FELONY AND UPON CONVICTION SUCH PERSON OR PERSONS SHALL BE PUNISHED BY A FINE NOT TO EXCEED FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000) OR BY IMPRISONMENT IN THE PENITENTIARY FOR NOT LESS THAN ONE (1) YEAR NOR MORE THAN TEN (10) YEARS, OR BOTH SO FINED AND IMPRISONED IN THE DISCRETION OF THE JURY.

EVERY PERSON, FIRM, OR CORPORATION OFFERING TO MAKE, OR PAY, OR GIVE, ANY REBATE, PERCENTAGE OF CONTRACT, MONEY OR ANY OTHER THING OF VALUE, AS AN INDUCEMENT OR INTENDED INDUCEMENT, IN THE PROCUREMENT OF BUSINESS, OR THE GIVING OF BUSINESS, TO ANY EMPLOYEE OR TO ANY OFFICIAL OF FLOYD COUNTY SCHOOLS, ELECTIVE OR APPOINTIVE, IN HIS EFFORTS TO BID FOR, OR OFFER FOR SALE, OR TO SEEK IN THE OPEN MARKET, SHALL BE DEEMED GUILTY OF A FELONY AND

SHALL BE PUNISHED BY A FINE NOT TO EXCEED FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000) OR BY IMPRISONMENT IN THE PENITENTIARY FOR NOT LESS THAN ONE (1) YEAR NOR MORE THAN TEN (10) YEARS, OR BOTH SO FINED AND IMPRISONED IN THE DISCRETION OF THE JURY.

NOTE: IT IS A MISDEMEANOR NOT TO HAVE THIS PROHIBITION ON EVERY SOLICITATION OR CONTRACT DOCUMENT. THE PENALTY IS A \$5,000 FINE OR ONE YEAR IMPRISONMENT OR BOTH ON CONVICTION.

GENERAL BID INSTRUCTIONS AND CONDITIONS FOR ALL BIDS

(PLEASE READ CAREFULLY)

A. **ACCEPTANCE OF BIDS**

The Board of Education reserves the right to accept any bid, to reject any or all bids, to waive any irregularities or informalities in bids received where such acceptance, rejection or waiver is considered to be in its best interest. The Board of Education also reserves the right to reject any bid where evidence or information submitted by the bidder does not provide satisfactory proof that the bidder is qualified to carry out the details of the contract.

B. **BID DOCUMENTS**

A bid form is provided to this "Invitation to Bid". All proposals must be submitted on the "Bid Form".

C. SPECIFICATIONS

Specifications are attached and are part of this proposal. All material or services furnished must be in conformity with the specifications and will be subject to inspection and approval of the Technology Department after delivery. The right is reserved to reject and return at the risk and expense of the supplier, any item which may be defective or fail to comply with these specifications.

It is important that each person submitting a bid follows carefully the specifications detailed herewith. The bidder is instructed to complete all blanks and spaces where information concerning any item is requested. Only items meeting the requirements are to be quoted on the regular bid form.

The Board of Education reserves the right to waive compliance of any material or services with any particular specification where such waiver is necessary due to technical errors or inconsistencies in the preparation of such specifications.

Product bid must meet or exceed all specifications as of the time and date of bid opening.

D. MODEL PROCUREMENT CODE

The Model Procurement Code (KRS 45A.) adopted by The Board of Education (BOE Policy 04.32) shall be deemed incorporated by reference in these specifications as though quoted fully herein. In the event of any conflict between this invitation to the bid and the Model Procurement Code, the statute shall take precedence.

E. LIABILITY INSURANCE/ PERFORMANCE BOND

The Board of Education, per local Board Policy, requires all vendors providing goods/services to the Floyd County Board of Education to name the Board of Education as an additional insured party with a liability limit of **\$2,000,000 per occurrence**. The Board of Education reserves the right to determine the ability of any bidder to perform the work, and any bidder shall, upon request, furnish such information as may be necessary to determine such ability, including performance bond, if requested.

F. EXCUSE FOR NON-PERFORMANCE

The successful vendor(s) shall be excused from performing hereunder during the time and to the extent that they are prevented from obtaining, delivering or performing in the customary way because of fire, strike, partial or total interruption of, loss or shortage of transportation facilities, lockout, commandeering of raw materials, products, plants or facilities by the government when satisfactory evidence thereof is presented to the other party, providing it is satisfactorily established that the non-performance is not due to the fault or negligence of the party not performing.

G. PENALTIES

In case of default by the vendor, The Board of Education may procure the articles or services from other sources and may deduct from any unpaid balance due the vendor for the amount of the excess cost so paid, and the price paid shall be considered the prevailing market price at the time such purchase is made.

H. TAXES

The Federal Excise Tax and the Kentucky Sales and Use Tax are not to be imposed as The Board of Education will furnish the successful bidder with proper tax exemption certificates upon request.

I. PRODUCT EVALUATION

Items will be disqualified that do not meet specifications or the accepted equal. If a product is purchased and it is later established that said product fails to comply with these specifications and conditions, the item will be rejected and returned to the supplier at the supplier's expense. No item shall be considered satisfactory that does not conform to our usual accepted methods, use, application, storage, handling and delivery. The decision concerning the satisfactory use and performance of any item on this bid shall be that of the Educational and Business Staff of The Board of Education.

J. BRAND NAMES

The brand or trade name, manufacturer's name, and/or catalog number must be given in the column provided. If bidder fails to indicate brand or trade name, where requested, the item bid may be disqualified.

K. NON-DISCRIMINATION

During the performance of this Contract, the Seller agrees as follows:

(1) The seller shall not discriminate against any employee, applicant or subcontractor because of age, color, creed, handicap condition, marital or parental status, national origin, race, sex, veteran status, or political opinion or affiliation. The seller shall take affirmative action to ensure the applicants are employed, and that employees are treated during employment without regard to their age, color, creed, handicap condition, marital or parental status, national origin, race, sex, veteran status, or political opinion or affiliation. Such action

shall include, although not limited to, the following: Employment, upgrading, demotion or transfer, recruitment or recruitment advertising, layoff or termination, rates of pay or other forms of compensation, and selection for training, including apprenticeship. The seller agrees to post in conspicuous places, notices setting forth the provisions of this equal opportunity clause.

(2) The Seller shall in all solicitations and/or advertisements for employees placed by or on behalf of the Seller, state that all qualified applicants shall receive consideration for employment without regard to age, color, creed, handicap condition, marital or parental status, national origin, race, sex, veteran status, or political opinion or affiliation.

(3) The Seller shall cause any subcontractor engaged to perform any services required by this contract to include this Equal Opportunity clause in all solicitations, advertisements and employment practices it shall perform.

L. DELIVERY

The contractor agrees to deliver and install the items within the terms of the contract as the Technology Department may prescribe.

All cost for delivery, including drayage and freight, and for the packaging of said articles are to be borne by the bidder, and must be included in your bid prices.

If during the period of the contract it is necessary that the Finance Department place toll or long distance telephone calls in connection therewith (for complaints, adjustments, shortages, failure to deliver, etc.), it is understood that the vendor will bear the charge or expense for all such calls.

M. SAMPLES

Samples may be requested to assist in making decisions for awarding of contracts. The samples must be furnished by time and date specified for bid opening. Failure to furnish samples may disqualify any bid.

Samples shall be identical to and meet all specifications of items on which the bid is submitted and will be checked and deemed necessary by The Board of Education for compliance with specifications outlined herein. Samples are to be properly marked for identification and they must indicate the suppliers name and the corresponding item number as shown in the invitation to bid. If samples are required, and they are not claimed by the indicated date, the samples will become the property of The Board of Education.

All samples are to be furnished without cost to The Board of Education with the right reserved to mutilate, consume or destroy such samples if considered necessary for testing purposes.

Note: Bid samples should not be submitted unless expressly requested.

N. K.O.S.H.A. STANDARDS AND HAZARD COMMUNICATION STANDARD 1910.1200

If applicable, all materials and services must meet or exceed K.O.S.H.A. (Kentucky Occupational & Safety Health Act) Standards, and must comply with the Hazard Communications Standard 1910.1200 of the Occupational Safety & Health Administration.

O. BIDS

(1) Businesses that fail to submit bids on two (2) consecutive procurements of similar items may be removed from the applicable bidder mailing list.

(2) Tabulations will be made by the Technology Department and each qualified bidder will be mailed a formal tabulation after The Board of Education has taken official action. The Board of Education meetings are normally held once a month. Bidders are requested not to call the Technology Department for a tabulation of the bids.

(3) Any bids received after scheduled time of opening will be returned unopened to the bidder.

(4) Each bid must be in a separate sealed envelope with the name of the bidder appearing in the top left hand corner of the envelope.

(5) No bid can be corrected or altered or signed after being opened. The Board of Education will not be responsible for errors or omissions on the part of bidders in making up their bids. Any bids received unsigned will be rejected.

(6) All regular bids must be submitted in accordance with specifications on the bid form supplied with this invitation. The submission of a bid on the bid form certifies that the product meets any and all specifications, except as noted on such forms.

(7) For any clarification relative to this bid, contact Denise Isaac, Chief Instructional Officer, Floyd County Schools, 442 KY RT 550, Eastern, Ky. 41622, Telephone (606) 886-2354.

P. PRICES AND/OR PERCENTAGES OF DISCOUNT

(1) All prices and/or percentages of discounts quoted by the various bidders must be firm for the time period indicated under "Period of Contract".

(2) All prices and quotations must be in ink or typewritten. No pencil figures will be permitted. Mistakes are to be crossed out and corrections inserted adjacent thereto and initialed by person signing bid. Also, corrections made with correction tape or fluid is to be initialed.

(3) Quote on each item separately. Prices must be stated in units specified herein.

(4) Cash discounts of less than 20 days will be considered net. Cash discounts, when given, will be figured from date of receipt of invoice or receipt of merchandise, whichever is later.

(5) Discount terms will be considered in determining the low bidder.

(6) Bids that have clerical errors or irregularities are subject to correction only with concurrence with the Finance Department. Unit prices should be listed, extended, and totaled where applicable. Should errors exist in the extended price, the unit price will prevail.

(7) If quoting fractional pricing, it must be rounded to the fourth digit.

Q. OR EQUAL CLAUSE

(1) Whenever, in any of the contract documents, an article, materials or equipment is described by use of a proprietary product or by using the name of the manufacturer or vendor, the term "or equal", if not inserted, is implied.

(2) The use of a specific article or manufacturer's name shall be construed as indicating the type of equipment, design, general construction, quality and finish. Such use shall not be construed as limiting or excluding any manufacturer's product of comparable quality design and efficiency.

R. DESCRIPTIVE LITERATURE AND/OR MANUFACTURER'S SPECIFICATIONS

The Board of Education reserves the right to waive any discrepancies or inconsistencies between the submitted manufacturer's descriptive literature and/or specifications and the requirements of this invitation to bid, if; (1) the bidder actually submits a sample which conforms to all material requirements of this invitation to bid; or (2) the bidder certifies to The Board that the bidder can actually supply products which conform to all material requirements of this invitation to bid.

NOTE: Descriptive literature and/or manufacturer's specifications should not be submitted unless expressly requested.
