Consider/Approve the creation of the Work Based Learning (WBL) "KCS D Service Learning Nurse Support Program" to provide KCS D scholars from the Ignite Pre-Nursing Pathway, Ignite Biomedical Science Pathway, the District State Testing Nursing Assistant (STNA) Program, and other scholars interested to have a real world experience working with the KCS D School Nurses for the 2021-2022 School Year.

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

KCS D has established career pathways in the health science field that include four course pathways in Pre-Nursing and also in Biomedical Sciences. In addition to a certification course in STNA. Currently the COVID-19 has caused a high level of contact tracing work on the 18 KCS D schools. The new KCS D Service Learning Nurse Support Program will provide KCS D Scholars the opportunity for real world experience working and learning from the school nurses to complete the contact tracing cases. Scholars will earn high school credit. The WBL provides scholars another Transition Ready opportunity.

FISCAL/BUDGETARY IMPACT:

Approximately \$200,000 from the General Fund (36 WBL Scholars @ \$12.58 per hour at 3.0 hours per day for 137 Days (Oct. 1st, 2021 through May 16th, 2022) + 9% overhead costs.

RECOMMENDATION:


