DAILY OPERATIONS

NUE VUE

- We have 26 students actively participating in the virtual / hybrid option.

RESPONSE TO INTERVENTION (WHAT I NEED)

- Mr. Skaggs, Ms. Riley, Ms. Shroyer, and Ms. Young have been working diligently to restructure our RTI programs from the ground up. We are now calling it WIN time, or "What I Need."
- Using the latest MAP data, the middle school students are placed in either math / reading intervention and enrichment. The intervention rotations will last 4 weeks and the enrichment rotations will last 1 week.
- The high school teachers will be able to pull students for two consecutive days of intervention and will also offer enrichments two days a week. Students will self select the enrichments. Some of the enrichment offerings include:
 - Content-Based or Real-life based/job/interview skills/resumes
 - Guest Speakers
 - Cooking
 - Taxes / Finances
 - Automotive Tech / Repair
 - Coding / 3D Printing
 - Photography
