Grants in Progress:

- **GEER II Grant** - The FRYSC centers were awarded \$100,000 for GEER II funds for 2 year expenditure period beginning 7-1-21. This will be a combined FRYSC grant for each center. Budget plan is for Child Care, Youth Leaders, GROW sessions, Relatives raising Relatives program.
- **McKinney Vento Grant** – This grant was just awarded/renewed for another 3 years. Bellevue/Dayton/Southgate are partnering and Ericka Huff will continue as McKinney-Vento Coordinator. Award amount is \$107,215.00 per year.
- **Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Grant** – The grant was awarded to Lincoln Elementary School. Award amount is \$50-\$75 per student. I will provide exact amount when funds are received.
- **Positive Action Grant** – This is a multi-district grant. This is LES only, with grades 2,4,6 are participating. This project is being coordinated by Amanda Minser.
- FY21 Kentucky Innovative Learning Network Partnership - \$10,000 award that will allow us to continue our work with Gallup, including Clifton Strengths and the Q12 employee engagement survey.
- **Preschool Partnership Grant** – This grant has been submitted and winners will be notified around September 17, 2021. – We were awarded this grant!

Grants Pending:

- KDE Comprehensive Literacy Grant – Unfortunately we did not receive this grant
- **IAL Grant** – Southgate, Dayton, Fleming. This grant has been submitted and awards will be announced late September/early October. This is a 5 year grant. – Still Pending
- McKinney Vento Sub grant – This was a quick turnaround grant. You had to be awarded the McKinney Vento grant in order to apply for this. The total amount requested over a 2 year period is \$97,000.
