



Legislative Update

- Kentucky Board of Education mask mandate is repealed (Thursday, September 16th)
- Requires KDPH to develop universal “test to stay” model program
- Requires the local health department to provide assistance in plans for masking, contact tracing, and quarantining
- Remote Learning Flexibility for the remainder of the Fall semester (20 Days)
- Ability to use 2018-2019 ADA for funding purposes (as has been done the last two school years)
- Requires staff to work on site during NTI or Remote Learning Days if the day is COVID related
- Flexibility on substitute teacher requirements for the 2021-2022 school year
 - At least 64 hours of College Credit; or
 - A high school diploma or equivalent with 4 years of work experience in education, child care, or the subject area taught
- Classified Staff can perform classroom instructional activities without supervision of certified teachers for the 2021-2022 school year



Legislative Update

- Home hospital instruction can be done by classified staff for the 2021-2022 school year
- From now until January 15th retirees can return to work with only one month of separation
- Waived the 170 day school year requirement as long as 1062 instructional hours are met
