DUAL CREDIT
Memorandum of Agreement

Between

Campbellsville University

and

Jefferson County Public Schools
3325 Newburg Rd

The purpose of this agreement is to set forth the terms and conditions required to award credit for Campbellsville University dual credit courses successfully completed by high school students attending a Jefferson County Public Schools (JCPS) site.

This agreement allows students to earn college credit for comparable high school coursework. Upon enrollment at Campbellsville University, a student who has successfully completed one or more dual credit courses will have the option of completing his/her college program in less time. This agreement supersedes any previous dual credit agreement established between Campbellsville University and Jefferson County Public Schools in the same content area. This agreement is exclusive to JCPS and Campbellsville University, and no assurance is given that courses awarded through this agreement will transfer to any other postsecondary institution.

Campbellsville University is listed as a partnering school in the KHEAA offered Dual Credit Scholarship program for the Academic Year 2021-2022. Tuition for a dual credit course is set by KRS 164.786 at 40% of the KCTCS credit hour rate, offering our courses at \$72 per credit hour. Students who have previously exhausted their scholarship through another offering, will be responsible for the cost of these courses should they decide to enroll with Campbellsville University. We will be sending out an invoice in October for the fall term and in March for the spring term to each family. Students are also responsible for any books or materials used in the course as demonstrated by the faculty member.

Financial responsibility for unsuccessful completion of either course (W/U) will remain with Campbellsville University. If a student drops this course, it will need to occur within the first full week of classes. Grading procedures will be reflected in the course syllabus.

Neither party shall discriminate against any student, instructor, employee or other person because of race, color, national origin, age, religion, marital or parental status, political affiliation or beliefs, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression, veteran status, genetic information, disability or limitations related to pregnancy, childbirth, or related medical conditions.

Per Federal guidelines, students with an Individual Education Plan will receive documented services from the high school when taking Dual Credit courses on the high school campus with a high school teacher. Students taking courses at Campbellsville University will be connected to the Accessibility Resource Center (ARC).

Report on the Memorandum of Agreements with Campbellsville University for Dual Credit

Recommended Motion:

Superintendent Pollio recommends that the Board of Education approve the attached Memorandum of Agreement between Jefferson County Public Schools and Campbellsville University for dual credit courses and authorize the superintendent to sign the same.

Rationale

Dual Credit personnel from Campbellsville University have worked with the high school staff to identify teachers with the necessary credentials to offer dual credit for students scheduled in those courses. This agreement also allows students to take qualifying college courses on Campbellsville's Louisville campus or online for dual credit if courses or faculty are not available at the school level. The agreement aligns with the Dual Credit Scholarship Program. These dual credit courses can be transferred to any regionally accredited college or university for credit. Campbellsville University is a Partner Postsecondary Institution with KHEAA for that program.

Specifically:

- Scholarship funds may be used for dual credit unless the student has exceeded 2 courses or state funds are exhausted. In that case, the student/family is responsible for paying tuition.
- Tuition is set to 2/5 KCTCS tuition (as required by the PPI agreement with the KHEAA). Campbellsville will not charge JCPS for reimbursement of unsuccessful student tuition.
