PROGRAM DIRECTOR

Oversees all 21st Century Community Learning Centers Grants and Programs for Newport Independent Schools (K-12th)

Rate: 187 Days/7.5 hours

New Grants require 220 days @ 7 hrs. per day

Responsible for:

- 1. Maintaining budgets for each grant (Creating PO's, reviewing Munis Reports)
- 2. Seeking out and applying for supplemental grants
- 3. Assist with writing 21st Century Cycle 19 Continuation grants for NIS & NHS
- 4. Oversee site coordinators
- 5. Collaborate with community partners to provide fun and educational enrichment opportunities
- 6. Collaborate with all school administration to identify and recruit students who will benefit from 21CCLC programming
- 7. Recruit certified and classified staff to work in our before, after and summer school programs
- 8. Maintain all KDE reporting for compliance
- 9. Work with KDE to ensure all grant requirements are met
- 10. Create programs and schedules



- 11. Work with other Student Support Services to provide our families and students with quality education and enrichment programs
- 12. Fill in any daily duties of the Site Coordinators if they are absent
- 13. Create and meet quarterly with an Advisory Councils for NPS, NIS, and NHS
- 14. Provide enrichment and academics for summer school students
- 15. Plan and implement six Adult Skill Building nights
- 16. Plan and implement three ELL family nights

ASSISTANT PROGRM DIRECTOR/SITE CORRDINATOR

Assists Program Director and NPS & NIS Site Coordinator

Rate: 156 days / 7 hours a day

(New Grant requires 220 days @ 7 hrs. per day)

- 1. Creates and maintains master schedules and rosters for each school and enrichment program.
- 2. Inputs all student data and attendance into the Cayen for NPS and NIS
- 3. Works daily as a site coordinator
- 4. Collaborates with all of our Enrichment Club teachers to ensure they are completing lesson plans and have all of the supplies needed for clubs
- 5. Collaborates with Homework Help and academic support teachers to ensure they have documents for students to work on during that time.
- 6. Helps assist the Program Director with KDE reports and PO's
- 7. Maintains daily office operations including but not limited to:
 - a. Filing
 - b. Copying
 - c. Distribution of materials to students and staff
 - d. Calling parents



NHS Site Coordinator

Rate: 19 hours per week

- 1. Recruits students for programming
- 2. Oversees the after school program at the high school
- 3. Inputs all student information and attendance into Cayen System
- 4. Collaborates with Enrichment Club leaders to ensure they have all supplies needed
- 5. Collaborates with high-school teachers to get missing assignments for club students to finish during Homework Help
- 6. Maintain a master schedule and rosters for each club
