### **AGENDA ITEM (ACTION ITEM):**

Consider/Approve the exercising of optional renewal 2 of 2 of the Farming Bid with Aaron Bunch for the period of May 7, 2019 through February 28, 2020

## <u>APPLICABLE BOARD POLICY:</u> Fiscal Management 04.32 AP.1

#### **HISTORY/BACKGROUND:**

The Board voted at the regular meeting on June 5, 2017 to accept the only bid received from Aaron Bunch to farm the 1033 Walton Nicholson Road property. The Board voted at the March 5, 2018 to exercise option 1 of 2 of the bid. Mr. Bunch proposes to continue to raise soybeans through October/November, followed by winter wheat to prevent soil erosion. He would also be responsible to check the property weekly for trash and mow it as needed. No money would be exchanged as a part of this agreement. This would be the second of two mutual optional renewals.

**<u>FISCAL/BUDGETARY IMPACT</u>**: No fiscal impact.

#### **<u>RECOMMENDATION:</u>**

Exercise the second of two mutual optional contract renewals for the farming of the 1033 Walton Nicholson Road property with Aaron Bunch for the period of May 7, 2019 through February 28, 2020.
