Consider/Approve Approve the Simon Kenton fee of \$150 per course charged to students to attend summer school to retrieve credits lost (courses failed) during the 2018 - 2019 school year. The fee is lowered to \$75.00 for reduced lunch students and \$25.00 for free lunch students.

#### **HISTORY/BACKGROUND:**

Summer school credit recovery will run from June 3 - June 28, 2019. Students needing to makeup credits can attend for \$150 per course with the possibility of taking two courses over the summer. Students will attend Monday – Friday. The fee being charged is to offset the cost of instructors for this program and snacks for the participants.
