AGENDA ITEM (ACTION ITEM):

Consider/Approve the Proposal from Motz Group to replace the existing Synthetic Turf Field System at Simon Kenton High School.

APPLICABLE BOARD POLICY: Fiscal Management 04.32 AP.1

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

It is necessary to replace the existing synthetic turf field system at Simon Kenton High School. The current field has been well maintained which has contributed to the extension of useful service of the field beyond the ten (10) year expected lifespan. Recent G-Max testing results have demonstrated the need to replace the turf in order to achieve the required safety test score of 200.

The Motz Group is listed as an approved vendor for the State of Kentucky through the AEPA (Association of Educational Purchasing Agencies). The AEPA Purchasing Agreement allows District Staff to review and evaluate various options available through the Motz Group purchasing contract. The Motz proposal includes color choices, lettering, field striping, logo selections, shock attenuation pad, and replacement of existing communication boxes. Motz Group Staff will perform a drainage test and inspection in order to verify the integrity of the original subsurface drainage system. Additional work and cost may be necessary depending on the outcome of the drainage test. District Administration will provide a future update and amendment to the original base bid proposal submitted by Motz Group should any subsurface remediation work be necessary.

FISCAL/BUDGETARY IMPACT:

The total cost of the base bid is \$512,183.00 to be paid from Capital Outlay Funds. Additional costs may be incurred depending upon the final results of the drainage test to be performed at the onset of the project.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the Motz Group Proposal for the replacement of a synthetic turf field system at Simon Kenton High School.

SCOPE OF WORK

PRECONSTRUCTION

- Lead and organize a preconstruction meeting with the owner's team
- Provide drawings and turf submittals for turf system design
- Furnish dumpsters and remove all field construction-related trash and debris

TURF REMOVAL

- Cut and roll of existing turf
- Clean prep site for turf installation
- Provide up to 50 tons of fine stone to help with leveling of existing base and low areas around edges
- Laser grade existing stone base
- Perform drainage test prior to turf installation

TURF AND INSTALLATION

- Furnish and install The Motz Group's synthetic turf system, 2", 38oz, Twenty-Four Seven ® slit-film with 20mm shock attenuation pad
- Secure all 15' wide main panels of turf by state-of-the-art <u>SEWN</u> seaming methods and premium adhesives to ensure maximum bonding
- Furnish and install field markings
 - Full football markings including sidelines, hash marks, numbers and arrows
 - Colored restriction/coach's box
 - o Soccer markings full in black
 - o center SK logo, approx. 35' tall
 - o "PIONEERS" in each end zone, single color, 15' tall
 - o Add colored end zones, standard colors palette
 - Add KCSD logo in two locations on field
 - o Add media line, dashed
- Install engineered rubber and sand infill mix to maximize playability and performance
- Provide four (4) new comm boxes and lids

MAINTENANCE & WARRANTY

- Provide owner's manuals <u>AND</u> training by The Motz Group and our Motz Group employed technicians
- Provide inspection of all seams, fiber and infill depth by authorized Motz representative
