- 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Applications: Ms. Weber has started working with the 8<sup>th</sup> grade students to complete their high school applications for next year. She teaches them during their elective time one day a week to create their cover sheets/resumes, fill out applications, and find admission information on the schools they wish to attend as freshmen. Although most of the local high schools have pushed back their application deadlines until the spring, we hope to have everyone's paperwork completed before we leave for the winter break.
- Postive Action SEL Curriculum: Ms. Weber has continued to collaborate with homeroom teachers to provide the Positive Action SEL curriculum for all students. Currently, all classes are completing the first unit of the curriculum and working to fill out the administration surveys required to meet the stipulations of the grant. Ms. Weber has assisted the teachers in completing the surveys, and she is still teaching the curriculum in 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and, most recently, 4<sup>th</sup> grade. Ms. Weber and Mrs. Hansman will meet with the grant coordinators this Thursday (Nov. 11) to receive updates about the grant initiative and to ensure that we are in compliance.
- **MAP Testing:** The second round of MAP testing will begin in December. Ms. Weber will proctor the test for the primary classes (K-3) in the computer lab, and she will oversee the administration of the test in the classrooms for the older students (4-8).
