2. Student Achievement

2.1- iReady Report [Fall iReady](#), Results show that many of our students are about one grade level behind. Second Grade is a little concerning, several 2nd graders are two grade levels behind.

2.2- RTI update- Interventions will be based on the beginning of the year data. RTI groups are working to service the students with Red Folders.

2.3- Curriculum Updates

Math- All grade levels have had their Module Meetings. The Module Meetings consist of looking ahead to the next module and to address concerns of supplies, techniques, and strategies.

Science-Teachers are beginning to teach from TCI: Science Alive. The materials kits for each grade level have arrived and have been delivered.

Social Studies- The teacher leaders are still working to adjust the curriculum maps. All of the materials have been delivered to the classrooms. Mrs. Yantz expressed concerns that Social Studies needs to be taught at every grade level using the new curriculum.
