Consent Agenda Item (Action Item): Consider the addition of 1650 single subject license of NWEA MAP Growth Assessment for all 6-8 Students at all Floyd County Schools.

Applicable State or Regulations: Board Policy 01.11 General Powers and Duties of the Board

Fiscal/Budgetary Impact: The addition of MAP Growth Assessments for all 6-8 grade students at all Floyd County Schools will cost \$10461.00 (*see attached Quote)

History/Background: MAP stands for Measures of Academic Progress and is a computerized assessment that provides administrators, teachers, students and parents with the information they need to improve teaching and learning. Utilizing data from the testing reports, administrators and teachers can make student-focused, data-driven decisions for individualized instruction. The Student Profile Report gives you a complete picture of the student's learning in one place, making it easier and faster to differentiate instruction and set goals for growth. It also assists in determining instructional areas and skills to focus on the continued growth. Class Level Reports gives you key information for instructional grouping by class, as well as helping you see students who aren't achieving or growing as quickly as others. School and District Reports provides a means to dive deeper into the district's academic performance which will be needed to make program and District-Wide decisions. The data provided will assist schools and teachers greatly in providing on-time MTSS services. MAP Assessment will be given 3 X's yearly and results will be analyzed to inform instruction and programming for students. The addition of the 1650 license will include testing all 6-8 students in Math, Reading, Science and Language Usage. Assessing students with the same measure in Grades K-8 will provide the district and schools with more longitudinal data that will better guide schools and the district in determining the learning needs of all students in elementary and middle school years.


Recommended Action: Approve the renewal of the addition of 1650 student licenses of MAP Growth Assessment for all grade 6-8 students at all Floyd County Schools.
