**LINCOLN COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT
DISTRICT FACILITIES PLAN HEARING REPORT**

A public hearing was held at the Lincoln Student Support Center on 10/14/21 at 5:30 P.M. (local time). The purpose of the public hearing was to propose a new District Facility Plan developed by the Lincoln County Local Planning Committee. The Local Planning Committee (LPC) voted 11-0 in favor of the proposed new plan and the Board of Education voted 5-0 to approve the new plan.

The Director of Operations, Darren Yaden was the only one in attendance. Tim Eaton, KSPMA Field Consultant, served as the locally-appointed hearing officer.

COMMENTS

Tim Eaton called the public hearing to order. The hearing officer highlighted the proposed amended District Facility Plan as follows; Under Capital Construction Priorities (Scheduled within the 2022-2024 Biennium) 1b., Construction of a new 500 student capacity elementary school on a site TBD. Under 1c.1., Major renovations/additions are noted for The Lincoln Co. ATC 2002 section. 1c. 2., Major renovation to Lincoln County Middle School, 1992 and 2006 sections. Under 1c. 3., Major renovation to Lincoln Co. High School 1974 and 1976 sections. Under 1c. 4., Major renovations the 1996 and 2017 sections to include HVAC pumps, HVAC, and additional security upgrades. Under Capital Construction Priorities (Schedule after the 2022-2024 Biennium) 2.c, Major renovations/additions are listed for Crab Orchard Elementary and Hustonville Elementary. There are no items listed under construction of non-educational additions or expansions or under management support areas. Under Discretionary Construction Projects the plan lists renovation and an addition to Lincoln Co. High School Athletic Fieldhouse, renovation and an addition to Lincoln High Baseball facility, Turf field at Lincoln High for multiple athletics teams and band practice, Lincoln High gym floor replacement, Lincoln Middle gym floor replacement, complete infield construction at the Lincoln Middle School, renovate Kings Mountain gymnasium and at Lincoln County School / McGuffey, construct one corridor and commons area plus construct one central administrative suite.

The floor was opened to those who wished to make a statement. There were no comments offered and no written comments were submitted. The hearing was adjourned.

RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the new District Facility Plan as developed by the Lincoln County Local Planning Committee and adopted by the Lincoln County Board of Education be approved as the District Facility Plan for the Lincoln County School District.
