- * All fees are based on our current fire inspector, Mike Meyer, who is considerably less expensive (sometimes by 50% +) than most inspectors in the area. Mike Meyer has performed the inspections since 2013, when Emergency Systems, LLC. was awarded the bid. If he can no longer perform the inspections for any reason, a new quote will be submitted to Kenton County Board of Education.
