## MUNICIPAL ORDER 47-2021

A MUNICIPAL ORDER AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN APPLICATION FOR CYBERSECURITY PREPAREDNESS GRANT FUNDING THROUGH THE KENTUCKY LEAGUE OF CITIES INSURANCE SERVICES ASSOCIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,000.00, THE PROCEEDS OF WHICH WILL BE UTILIZED BY THE CITY OF OWENSBORO FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES ALREADY INCURRED; NO MATCH REQUIRED FROM THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the Kentucky League of Cities Insurance Services Association (KLCIS) offers a Cybersecurity Preparedness Grant to its insureds as a risk management tool against cyberattacks; and

WHEREAS, the City of Owensboro has expended funds for multi-factor authentication, data backup and disaster recovery, and endpoint detection in its efforts to prevent cyberattacks; and

**WHEREAS,** the City seeks reimbursement for amounts expended to prevent cyberattacks through the Cybersecurity Preparedness Grant awarded by KLCIS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE CITY OF OWENSBORO, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** That the Mayor be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to execute a grant application to be filed with the Kentucky League of Cities Insurance Services Association for Cybersecurity Preparedness Grant funds in the amount of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) for reimbursement of amounts already expended, for which no match is required from the City.

Section 2. That the Mayor, City Manager and appropriate staff members are

hereby authorized to sign any and all other documents deemed necessary to the furtherance of the authority outlined herein.
