A. Mountain Movers

Certified Mountain Mover Kristy Floyd

Kristy is a National Board Certified teacher who has been employed with the Estill County School District for 13 years. She teaches 5th grade at West Irvine and has also taught 2nd grade at Estill Springs.

Classified Mountain Mover Bill Lynch

Bill has been an employee of the Estill County School District since 2003. He began his career as a bus aide and now works in the maintenance department and also fills in at custodial positions throughout the district as needed.

Community Mountain Mover Estill County Lions Club

Estill County Lions are among some 3.5 million Lions in over 25,000 Lions Clubs in 205 countries around the globe. Within the guidelines of LCI, we have broadened our main mission to primarily help the people of Estill County. Estill Lions offer free or low-cost prescription glasses for the needy and free reading glasses at several locations, including the Library. Estill Lions are partners with Estill County schools, offering support such as free vision screening, reading to preschoolers (halted due to Covid) and working with Family Resource personnel in the Estill Schools. During the flooding last spring, Lions contacted Mike Flynn and, with his help, selected several

families (a total of 41 people, including many children) to support, using a \$5,000 grant from LCIF (Lions Club International Fund). Partnering with Leggett and Platt, Lions helped provide beds, mattresses, bedding, and clothing, and household goods for these families.

The club offers a \$500 needs-based scholarship to an Estill senior each year. We help Kiwanis with the bell ringing for the Salvation Army for one weekend at Christmas time. Lions also support Helping Hands and provide hygiene kits to various agencies. Those mentioned above are just a few of the local actions taken by Estill Lions. Our district recently recognized them as being the second most active club in Eastern Kentucky.
