Background:

Existing Policy: Board Policy 04.8, Board Procedure 04.8 AP.1

Summary of Issue: Request permission to sell for scrap outdated and nonfunctioning equipment. **Clothes dryer** is non-functioning and must be replaced. **Deep Fryer** is outdated and nonfunctioning. **Dough Mixer** is outdated and nonfunctioning, also.

Budget Impact: Minimal increase from scrap metal check deposit to Fund 51

Groups Consulted and Brief Summary of Response: Maintenance Director, Brad Abee, and Food Service Director, Mindy Morrow, agree that **all three pieces of small equipment** are outdated and/or non-functioning, and should be sold for scrap.
