The funds available from KYTC was not \$434,991.00, but was only \$266,642.00, and the BG5 did not show the investment earnings of \$287,269.47 in the column (Current Funds Available).

**Recommended Action:** Approve the revised BG1 and withdraw the BG5. Once the revised BG1 has been approved by KDE, we will bring the BG5 back to the board.

Foundation system to be structuralslab on concrete caissons to bedrock. Interior finshes to be "low maintenance" finishes. HVAC to be geothermal system. 


