Overview

Bullitt County Public Schools is committed to providing an exceptional comprehensive educational system where all students can reach their full potential, in accordance with the skills and competencies of the BCPS Graduate Profile.

Our Board strongly believes that the District is accountable to the community for equipping our students with the knowledge, skills, and dispositions that will prepare them to become the next generation of leaders in the Bullitt County Community. The current accountability system in the Commonwealth, which is driven by a singular accountability measure drawn from a student's performance on state assessments, is a partial accounting and does not adequately represent the comprehensive work of the district regarding developing the whole student.

The BCPS Community Accountability Profile will not replace the state KPREP model. BCPS will continue to value state assessment results for growth opportunities, however, we believe no school system or school can be solely measured by an annual standardized assessment given to students during one time period. Rather, true accountability is a systemic, holistic review of the work of the district that is grounded in forward-facing progress versus annual summative reviews with regards to educating the whole child.
