- Youth Service Center Holiday Report
 - Thanksgiving
 - 125 families in the Dayton community were provided with food through the help of St. Bernard's and other community members.
 - Christmas
 - 400 students will receive gifts for the holiday season. The high school currently has about 130 students identified for Christmas assistance. 65 plus Christmas meals will also be provided to our families through various community agencies and St. Bernard's.
