- All students in grades kindergarten through sixth grade are taking their Winter AIMSweb benchmark assessments in the subjects of math and reading.
- The LES Principals and School Counselor have determined students who are struggling academically and have helped them develop a plan of goals for improvement. Using a strength-based approach, we are working with students to identify areas of growth and goal setting. The students identified were failing one or more of their core classes.
- Our afterschool club offerings and sports continue to grow. We are currently offering: Robotics Club, Chess Club, Gardening Club, Art Club, Academic Team, Club Unify, LES News, Chorus, Student Council, STLP, The FIVE, and Youth Basketball. Our Drama Club will begin immediately following winter break.
