HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

Following the release of the 2021 state assessment results from the Kentucky Department of Education, collaboration took place across the district to create a draft plan for district improvement. This plan not only incorporates the state assessment data, but reflects our current KCSD 2021-2022 Action Plan, with strategies and action steps outlined within the seven Pillars of the Community Based Accountability System (CBAS). The CDIP is reflective of the KCSD Action Plan and aligns to the state required section of: Continuous Improvement, the District Assurances, the District Safety Report, the Needs Assessment, the Executive Summary, the Comprehensive Improvement Goals, the Superintendent Gap Assurances, and Professional Development. A forum for the purposes of input from a teacher representative, Board members, and parent/community member was hosted on the CDIP on December 8, 2021.


