Radcliff Elementary serves students in grades 1-5 and is located in Hardin County, in the city of Radcliff. Radcliff Kentucky sits just outside the gates of the U.S. Army instalation Fort Knox. This area has a high unemployment rate -hovering at about 5% with approximately 20% of families living in poverty; approximately 30% of our students participate in the Backpack Program that provides food on Fridays for the weekend. There are approximately 375 students at Radcliff Elementary. However, students move in and out frequently with approximately 15% of our student population being transient throughout the year. Approximately 50% of our student population is minority. Although the majority of our students qualify for free or reduced lunch, all of our students revceive free breakfast and lunch because we are identified as Community Eligibility Provision school. In addition, approximately 10% of our students receive mental health services through local agencies and programs. Currently we have 31 certified staff members, 17 classified staff members, 1 counselor, 1 assistant principal, 1 principal, and 1 family resource coordinator. Radcliff Elementary experiences high staff turn over.
