There are 506 students at Vine Grove Elementary School. The school is located in a residential community, less than 10 miles from Fort Knox military base which attributes to a very transient population. Vine Grove Elementary shares property with the neighboring middle school. The School Administration consist of a Principal, Assistant Principal, and a Counselor. We have 23 homerooms, grades 1-5, with five National Board Certified teachers out of 20 certified teachers. We have a staffing population of 95% Caucasian. The community is mostly low-income residential area, which tends to become a problem with homework help and studying skills because of priority.

We offer many programs that help student develop ownership of their work, and also based on the student needs of each different grade level.

In the last three years, our school has implemented Orton Gillingham for our phonics program in our primary grades, implementing one grade at a time. This year we adopted the iReady program which consists of iReady diagnostic which directly correlates with iReady reading and math programs, allowing students to practice reading and math at the level at which they can perform independently. 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started the 2020-2021 school year in an A/B schedule, meaning that students only attended in-person instruction two days a week and completed online work the other three days of the week. Eventually, we were able to bring our students back to full time five days a week by the end of the year. This was a major logistical achievement for Vine Grove, as we created online classrooms and became very flexible with teaching. Vine Grove Elementary School has created a STEM class that reaches all students in the school in the areas of math, science, and technology. We also hired a full time ESSER Support teacher to support the areas of reading and math.
