Welcome to Colonel's Corner Bank: The Banking Entity Inside Henderson County High School

Colonel's Corner Bank (CCB) is a service-based high school program located inside Henderson County High School. Since its inception in 1996, CCB has created a unique environment and real-world banking experience for students who feel that a financial career might be in their future.

IT ALL STARTED IN A CLOSET

Through the sponsorship of Field & Main Bank and the recognized effort to contribute to the community, Colonel's Corner Bank rapidly grew from a small-time operation in an unused janitorial closet to a student-run banking entity for all students and faculty.

With Field & Main's help, a course curriculum was developed, which was approved by the state of Kentucky. CCB now operates during the lunch hour every single weekday.

SERVICES OFFERED AT CCB:

Students and faculty can make deposits and withdrawals, and they can even be granted a loan for up to \$50. These loans are typically issued to students who need extra cash for things like yearbooks or extra school supplies.
