1. Two examples are the EXCITE Team lead by Instructional Chief, Davida Marson. This team serve as mentors, meet, plan and share best practice and innovative strategies monthly. The EXCITE or Experts,

- eXceptional, Change Agents, Innovative Leaders, Trustworthy Colleagues, and Explorers Team then shares the strategies within their own schools with teachers.
- 2. Another example is the New Teacher Cohort lead by Instructional Chief, Rachel Crider. Meeting topics and professional development planned are best practices and strategies in curriculum, instruction and assessment to help our new teaching team learn and grow for their students. Additionally, the cohort provides networking and support as a group.

 - 1. <u>KRS. 156.557</u> requires all school district administrators having the responsibility of evaluating certified personnel to be trained, tested, and approved in the proper techniques for effectively evaluating certified school employees.
- 2. Floyd County Schools has a Certified Employee Evaluation Plan (CEP) with EVALUATION PROCEDURES. The purpose of the certified employee evaluation plan is to help teachers, other professionals, principals, assistant principals, and district level administrators strengthen and improve their level of performance and effectiveness. We strive to create a safe, supportive environment that is conducive to optimal student learning. This goal will be achieved through the process of systematic efforts based on the shared responsibility of the evaluator and the evaluatee in a setting of mutual understanding, respect, and trust.
 - 1. Professional growth plans were reviewed together in Sept. and formative evaluation meetings occurring by Dec. 15th annually.
