Consider/Approve applying for emergency certification for a preschool teacher at Fort Wright Elementary for the remainder of the 2021-22 school year.

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

The KCS D posted a position on December 12, 2021, for a preschool teacher at Fort Wright Elementary. This vacancy was posted on the District's website, as well as on the Kentucky Department of Education's website "Kentucky Educator Placement Service". There are currently no available applicants who hold IECE certification. An applicant has been recommended for the Preschool position on an emergency certification basis who just completed the MAT program with an elementary education degree and meets the GPA requirements required by EPSB for this type of certification.

FISCAL/BUDGETARY IMPACT:

\$0-There is no additional cost to the district for emergency certification of a teacher and the teacher will be paid from the Board approved salary schedule based on the EPSB assigned rank.
