AGENDA ITEM (ACTION ITEM):

Consider/Approve rescinding the current Bus Fluids Bid Award to Apollo Oil, rejecting the new Bus Fluids Bid and utilizing state contracts and competitive negotiations for Bus Fluids.

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

The Bus Fluids Bid was awarded to Apollo Oil on June 2, 2021, for the period of July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022. On January 26, 2022, Apollo Oil notified the Purchasing Department that it could not fulfill the contract for diesel exhaust fluid (DEF) at the contracted price of \$1.09 per gallon due to market volatility, supply chain issues and DEF shortages. It was decided that Apollo Oil was in breach of contract for refusing to fulfill orders at the contracted price and the contract has been dissolved. A decision was made to issue a new bid for all line items but, no compliant or acceptable bids were received.
