Consider/Approve: Change Order No. 12 – Morel Construction – Scott High School Phase IV – BG 18-038

APPLICABLE BOARD POLICY:

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

This is the twelfth change order of the Scott High School – Phase IV project associated with Morel Construction Company. The original contract with Scott High School Phase IV is \$7,425,581.00. This change order for an additional \$6,856.00 with previous change orders of \$160,226.00 makes the new contract sum \$7,592,663.00.

Item 1: Furnish and install 100 amp breaker in existing emergency panel ELDP.

ADD:\$ 772.00

- Item 2: Furnish and install four (4) new fire suppression tamper switches throughout unrenovated existing building. ADD:\$ 1,253.00
- Item 3: During final inspection from the local planning authority, the following items were identified: reverse pipe drops and change pendent sprinkler heads to upright heads in the sound booth, replace several fire alarm devices with audio visual devices, provide and install remote disconnects at three (3) heat pumps to enable clearances that satisfy electrical inspector, and change sprinkler heads in calming rooms to institutional type heads. ADD:\$ 3,756.00
- Item 4: Delete unused landscape plantings
- Item 5: Furnish and install additional temporary exit signs and relocate exit signs as required by the building inspector. ADD:\$ 2,597.00
- Item 6: Furnish and install additional temporary egress lighting at Door #2200.4.

Item No 12-04 (RFCO-61) Delete unused landscape plantings. Cost Benefit to Owner: Provides credit for materials not provided. DEDUCT: \$4,700.00

Item No. 12-05 (RFCO-62 / RFP-29)

Furnish and install additional temporary exit signs and relocated exit signs as required by the building inspector. Cost Benefit to Owner: Required to obtain final occupancy certificate.

ADD: \$2,597.00

Item No. 12-06 (RFCO-64 / RFP-30) Furnish and install additional temporary egress lighting at Door #2200.4. Cost Benefit to Owner: Required to obtain final occupancy certificate.

ADD: \$928.00

Item No. 12-07 (RFCO-58) Premium time to install specified sealer to burnished block during weekend hours. Cost Benefit to Owner: Decreased fume exposure to building occupants. ADD: \$3,818.00

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Item No. 12-08 (RFCO-65)

Provide watchman for fire alarm/sprinkler system over summer and provide credit for use of Owner's electricity for temporary heaters during construction.

Cost Benefit to Owner: Allowed occupancy of building while alarm/sprinkler systems were disabled and provides reimbursement to Owner for contracor generated utility costs.
