Ignite Food Service Process Agreement 2019-20 Between Boone County Schools, Kenton County Schools and Walton-Verona Independent Schools

- 1) All students will fill out Free and Reduced Forms from their home district.
 - a. Boone will be complete on-line applications through daily processing.
 - b. All counties involved will accept applications through their process and will provide the information to Boone County Food Services within 3 business days of approval following the USDA guidelines.
 - c. Boone County Food Service will conduct a confirmation review of all applications from other districts involved.
 - d. Benefit approved will be effective on date of receipt of application by home district.
 - e. Applications will be processed within 3 business days upon receipt in the Boone County Food Service office.
- 2) Boone County is responsible for all program operations
 - a. Boone County will claim all meals served to students at Ignite.
 - b. No meals will be claimed by other districts for students enrolled in Ignite.
 - c. Boone County Food Service policies and procedures will be followed by Ignite.
- 3) Ignite Food Service will communicate with students from all Counties and Director of Food Service on collection of student charges,
 - a. Any charges remaining at the end of the year will be collected or reimbursed by the respective "home" District Office of the student.
 - b. All reasonable attempts will be made by Boone County Food Services throughout the school year to collect charges.
- Special Dietary Needs forms will be available at Ignite and also in each county and can be shared with Boone County Food Service for providing appropriate services for students.
