Consider/Approve: AP Science Lab Annual Stipend

APPLICABLE BOARD POLICY:

03.121 Certified Salaries

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

Several of our high schools offer Advanced Placement science courses. The course of study for these classes includes some detailed and lengthy lab assignments that cannot be completed within the regular 45 – 55 minute class schedule. On average, the labs last approximately 2.5 hours to complete including set up time. Therefore, some schools schedule these lab class sessions immediately after school so they may be completed in one sitting and produce the intended instructional results for the students.

The high schools would like to establish an annual AP Science Lab Stipend in the amount of \$2,500.00 to compensate the AP science teacher for the additional time setting up and instructing students during these AP lab sessions held after the school day. The stipend will include instructional time for approximately 24, 2.5 hour lab sessions per year and is based on the district's average teacher salary schedule. If the school's SBDM decides to schedule the AP labs after school as described above, the school would pay the annual stipend from their SBDM budget.


