Lesson Plans

Students have been working with the standards 1-LS1-1, 1-LS1-2, 1-LS3-1. These standards relate to heredity, how animals and plants protect themselves and how humans mimic plants and animals to protect themselves. The students are starting with learning about how plants and animals are similar to their parents by looking at pairs of animals (goat and kid, pig and piglet, horse and foal, etc.) The students are searching for similarities and differences.

Students will then work with how the animals protect themselves and what they learn from their parents about protecting themselves. They will look into animal life cycles and how they develop and grow to become strong adults.

After students learn ways animals learn from their parents to protect themselves, they will solve a STEM problem to show how people have learned from animals to protect themselves (bike helmets are like turtle shells).
