Currently Working On:

- <u>United Way grants</u>; the district has a total of three grants in-process for the United Way:
 - FRYSC District-wide: Safety Net Emergency Assistance grant; this grant currently funds the district-wide FRYSC Family Support Services program. We are requesting \$23,000 in funds to provide emergency assistance (food, clothing, shelter, furnishings, and utility assistance) to families of students who are in a financial crisis, and incorporating efforts to return the family to self-sufficiency.
 - Patriot Prep Program at Allen County Scottsville High School: we are seeking \$16,000 in funds to provide support to students to meet College and Career Readiness and Transition Readiness benchmarks at the high school, and participate in CTE and ACT boot camps. Funds will pay for college trips, dual-credit expenses for those who need it, boot camps, and career field trips.
 - Kindergarten Readiness: we are seeking \$15,000 in funds for Jumpstart Kindergarten, a week-long camp for incoming kindergarten students to increase kindergarten readiness for up to 100 students. The program will focus on literacy, language development, phonics and phonemic awareness, as well as on developing the components of reading, build vocabulary, and language development.
