The Kentucky High School Basketball Hall of Fame (KHSBHF) is proud to announce its "GLORY ROAD" project that will recognize and honor the many gymnasiums across Kentucky that have historical significance in the development of the cultural phenomenon of Kentucky high school basketball. For more than 100 years, Kentucky high school basketball has been embraced by Kentuckians who came together in gymnasiums of various shapes and sizes to support their teams.
