Lesson Plans

This field trip is for students with special needs K-5. We will be learning about plays (different lessons due to the varying grade levels, teachers, and abilities). Students will learn what a play is, the components of a play (characters, settings, acts, scenes etc), proper attire for a play (dress up), when to applaud, to stay on a level zero when the actors are acting, and more. We will focus on the content of the play, social and vocational skills during the play. When we return we will read the book, then compare and contrast the play to the book using a venn-diagram.

We will go to The Spaghetti Factory after the play. Before the field trip we will be learning about manners, social skills, etiquette on how to eat at a restaurant, goods and services, price of food, and tipping (again the lessons will be varied depending on the grade level and ability levels of the students). Many of our students have goals in that area and require lessons on how to behave in public, at a play, and a restaurant. This is a growth

area that we are seeing with our students and this would be a great teachable, real life experience for each one of them. Many of our students have never been to a play or don't eat out often at a sit down restaurant, or don't know how to properly.

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
