AGENDA ITEM (ACTION ITEM):

Consider/Approve Student Nutrition adopting the statewide point of service, Mosaic, and online payments platform, MySchoolBucks, effective May 2, 2022.

APPLICABLE BOARD POLICY:

07.1 Food/School Nutrition Services

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

The state of Kentucky is adopting a statewide point of service to streamline reporting and communications to the Student Information System, Infinite Campus. In August of 2022, 82% of school food authorities in the state of Kentucky will be utilizing Mosaic and MySchoolBucks. The current online payment platform, MyPaymentsPlus, charges a convenience fee of 4.88% paid by Student Nutrition. With the new online platform, parents are responsible for the \$2.75 per transaction fee. The convenience fee is only assessed for online payments. As part of the Request for Proposals Kentucky Department of Education had language to allow the state to collect a portion of the fees paid to offset the cost of the software for districts across the commonwealth. Families can continue to send a check or cash to the school cafeteria as to not incur a convenience fee. If the statewide point of service is approved families will be notified of the changes.


