

2022-2023 School Defined Course Codes For CCPS Board Approval

The Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) requires approval from the local Board of Education for the use of a 909999 course code before a district begins utilizing it within Infinite Campus. Course Code 909999 indicates the course is a "school defined course."

CCPS has two school defined courses that it would like to offer, beginning with the 2022-2023 school year. They are as follows:

Location: CCHS and HHS Course Code: 909999-FS

Course Name: Freshman Seminar

Course Credit: 1 Credit

Course Description: This is a mandatory anchor course for all freshmen that supports the transition process to high school through content like time management skills, test taking skills, important resources for academic success, and other support services. Additionally, students will explore all career pathway options in order to select their future pathway courses. The emphasis of this course is to prepare students for a successful high school experience.

Location: Gateway Academy

Course Code: 909999

Course Name: Exploring Teaching Career Options*

Course Credit: 1 Credit

Course Description: Exploring Teaching Career Options is the introductory course in the Teaching and Learning Pathway. It is designed to give scholars an overview of the education field. Throughout this course, scholars will explore five domains of topics relevant to the current practices and issues in education today. These topics include the professional educator, the students, the classroom, the community, and the profession of teaching. Field experiences are included in this course throughout the year. These experiences will be in a classroom setting across all grade levels and multiple content areas.

*Exploring Teaching Career Options was offered during the 2021-2022 school year; however, its course code was deprecated for the 2022-2023 school year. KDE recommends that the deprecated course code be replaced with the course code, 909999, indicating a "school defined course."
