The boys basketball team finished their season with an 18-13 record. They won the 6<sup>th</sup> District Tournament by beating a solid Union County team.

The girls basketball team finished at 24-5. They won the 6<sup>th</sup> District and 2<sup>nd</sup> Region Tournaments. They lost to Franklin County in the first round of the KHSAA Sweet 16 Tournament on March 9. Coach Haile currently has 793 wins, one win from second place all time in Kentucky Girls High School Basketball.

JJ Poynter won the region tournament for his weight class for wrestling team. The first since wrestling came back to Henderson in 2018. We had four state qualifiers, the most since wrestling returned.

Hayden Tichenor won the long jump at the State Indoor Track and Field Meet.

The swimming team finished the season undefeated in dual meets.

The dance team competed at Nationals and finished in 8<sup>th</sup> in Gameday (varsity), 18<sup>th</sup> in Pom (varsity) and 3<sup>rd</sup> in Gameday (JV).

Spring sports are underway. The softball team won their opening game on March 14 and the baseball team opened up on March 18. The first outdoor track meet and tennis match was on March 15.
