#### General Talking Points Caples)

-What did you notice about the test?

-Was there content on the test that you had not covered?

-How did students do navigating within the test?

#### Class Beta Report (Caples)

#### Achievement Status and Growth Summary Report (Merrick)

-By teacher - Percentage of students who met or exceeded their projected RiT are

-Grade Level - Add the total number of students from each homeroom that met or exceeded their projected RIT. Divide by the total number of students in the grade level. Looking for 50% growth or better

-1st-3rd (Class Report) Find the Mean RiT Score for each class that you teach - Add

4th - 6th (Class Report) Your Mean RIT should be calculated on your report for all of them together & divide by 2.

-Find the difference between the Mean RIT and the Grade Level Mean RIT.

-Looking for 2-3 points difference to make us high performing

#### Projected Proficiency Summary Report 3rd-6th Grade (Caples) -compare 20-21 KPREP, MAP Fall Projected Proficiency. MAP Winter Projected

-Identify kids who were not novice in fall but are novice in winter. Are they new to MLK?


