GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

THIS GENERAL WARRANTY DEED is made and entered into this 25 day of November, 2020, by and between STANVILLE PROPERTIES, LLC, a Kentucky limited liability company, whose mailing address is 2200 Ratliff Creek Road, Pikeville, Kentucky 41201, hereinafter referred to as GRANTOR, and the FLOYD COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION, whose mailing address is 442 KY RT 550, Eastern, KY 41622, hereinafter referred to as GRANTEE. WITNESSETH:

THAT the Grantor, for and in consideration of the sum of THIRTY THOUSAND AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$30,000.00), cash in hand paid, the receipt of all which is hereby acknowledged; the Grantor does hereby bargain, sell, grant and convey unto the Grantee, the FLOYD COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION, in fee simple, its successors and assigns, forever, with Covenant of GENERAL WARRANTY, the following described property situated in FLOYD County, Kentucky, and more particularly described as follows:

> Beginning at a point on the existing right of way of the Stratton Branch Waste Area Road, said point being a 5/8" rebar w/cap located 71.79' right of road centerline station 12+08.22, then running with the right of way N53°07'55"E, 50.03' to a 5/8" rebar w/cap, said point being 65.54' right of road centerline station 12+62.41, then N59°44'12"E, 61.81" to a roof bolt, said point being 60.36' right of road centerline station 13+29.15, then leaving right of way S45°41'34"E, 81.57' to a 5/8" rebar w/cap, said point being 134.97' right of road centerline station 13+66.65, then S52°02'32"W, 46.67' to a 5/8" rebar w/cap, said point being 147.49' right of road centerline station 13+12.33, thence \$52°02'32"W, 63.85' to a 5/8" rebar w/cap, said point being 159.64 right of road centerline station 12+35.11, thence N44°22'41"W, 90.82' back to the point beginning and containing .22 acres, more or less;

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD with all rights, privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, unto the Grantee. Granter hereby releases and relinquishes unto Grantee, its successors and assigns, all of the Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to the above described property, including all exemptions allowed by law; and the Granter does hereby COVENANT to and with the said Grantee that it is lawfully seized of the property herein

does hereby COVENANT to and with the said Grantee that it is lawfully seized of the property herein described, with good and perfect right to sell and convey the same, as is herein done, that the title thereto is free and clear from all encumbrances, except as herein provided, and that it will WARRANT GENERALLY the title thereto.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that there is excepted and this conveyance and the covenants herein made are expressly subject only to the following: [i] governmental laws, rules, regulations and restrictions affecting the Property, [ii] the lien of current ad valorem taxes and assessments, and all future ad valorem taxes and assessments, which Grantee hereby assumes and agrees to pay, [iii] all restrictions, covenants, essements, conditions, agreements, rights of way and stipulations of record affecting the Property, if any, and [iv] all planning and zoning and land use ordinances and regulations.
