Attached for the Board's review and consideration is the revised suggested fee to include an increase in cost for the student recorder for Elementary Schools.

This is the only change to the instructional fees that have been previously approved by the Board. Per Board policy, the proposed fees shall remain in place until modified or removed by Board resolution.

Consistent with Board Policy 09.15, students cannot be denied access/participation based on inability to pay. Schools will need to seek ways to assist students with waiver of fees.

Excerpt 09.15

INABILITY TO PAY

No child shall be denied full participation in any educational program due to an inability to pay for, or rent, necessary instructional resources. 1

WAIVER OF FEES

The Superintendent shall recommend and the Board shall approve a process to waive fees for students who qualify for free and reduced price meals. At the beginning of the school year or at the time of enrollment all students who qualify shall be given clear and prominent written notice of the fee waiver provisions. The written notice of the fee waiver process shall include a form that parents may use to request waiver of fees. Mandatory waiver of fees for qualifying students shall be accomplished in compliance with applicable statutory and regulatory requirements.²
