## **Request for Emergency Day for Kelly ES**

On Thursday morning, March 31, 2022, Kelly Elementary School was without electrical power. After consultation by school district staff with personnel from Duke Energy, it was discovered that the storm that had occurred overnight had damaged power lines because of extremely high winds associated with the storm. The damage from the storm to electrical lines in the area of Kelly Elementary School resulted in the electrical outage to the school.

In accordance with KRS 158.070 and 702 KAR 7:140, a request for an Emergency Day on March 31, 2022, for Kelly Elementary School, must be submitted to the Commissioner of Education for consideration. This request

must be supported by a Boone County Board of Education Order. If granted by the Commissioner, Kelly Elementary School will not be required to make up the day during the current school year. A letter from the Superintendent will be forwarded to the Commissioner along with the Board of Education Order.
