SUMMARY OF PRESENTATION:

Impact Kentucky is a working conditions survey administered biennially by the Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) and Panorama Education. This survey offers every certified educator in Kentucky the opportunity to provide anonymous feedback on teaching conditions that can inform school, district and state improvements. The survey covers topics relevant to the profession, including professional learning, school climate, resources, managing student behavior, school leadership and more.

This year, the KDE and Panorama Education received feedback from the Commissioner's Teacher Advisory Council and Principal Advisory Council to help shape the survey format and content. The survey takes approximately 20 minutes to complete and provides schools with critical data that guides implementation of policies and practices to maximize teacher effectiveness.

The 2022 Impact Kentucky survey was administered from November 17 to December 18, 2021. Panorama Education, whose mission revolves around helping educators use data to improve student outcomes, collected and analyzed the survey results. The data was released to superintendents and survey coordinators on February 3, 2022, and the public on February 10, 2022.

Panorama offered workshops, co-hosted by the KDE, that focused on data inquiry and action planning to help schools and districts utilize the data.

An update on the administration and results of the 2022 Impact Kentucky Survey will be shared with the Kentucky Board of Education through a PowerPoint presentation.

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
