Dear John:

We are writing on behalf of the Christian County School District to petition a waiver in accordance with 702 KAR 4:170, Part b, waivers:

Locker room shower heads

The Christian County Board of Education has approved Design Development plans for the above referenced project, based on a program that was achieved through multiple meetings with school district personnel. The KDE program for a high school requires 5 shower heads per locker room. The school as design has one ADA shower with one shower head per locker room at the request of the Athletic Director and the physical education instructors for a total of 3 boys showers, and 3 girls showers. The school has stated that students do not use lockers after PE Class anymore as they do not 'dress' for gym class and remain in their regular clothing.

There will be lockers room in both the Indoor Athletic Facility with the required amount of shower heads in the locker room, and the Concession Stand/Locker Room building also on site that will have the two additional showers each for boys and girls.
