History/Background:


These 30 students have been involved with numerous school and community activities the past two years. They volunteered at the Martin Community Center, helping distribute supplies to families that had been affected by flooding; volunteered at the Prestonsburg Health Care Nursing home delivering fruit baskets and spent time playing games with the residents; helped with the Districtwide Fun Fair for New and Expectant parents; hosted a duffle bag drive to ensure that each child in Floyd County entering into out of home care would have a bag to pack their belongings in when being removed; sponsored a Pet Food Drive, collecting 4500 pounds of food to be given to local animal rescues and the Floyd County Animal Shelter; participated in the Youth Leadership Conference through Huelife; hosted a community Easter Egg Hunt where there were over 200 people in attendance. Additionally, the council members perform countless daily tasks including helping during school assemblies, helping out in the office, making sure our food pantry is stocked and keeping the hygiene and clothing closets organized. At the beginning of the year we discussed doing something at the end of the school year to show how much they are appreciated for all they do and their immediate response was for a trip. This diversified group of students represent our Youth Services Center in such a positive way in our school and our community. Our motto is "Jags Give Back" and now we want to give back to our council for all of their hard work both in schools and out in the community.


